

Stefan Ingves

Stefan Ingves took up the post of Governor of the Riksbank (Central Bank of Sweden) and Chairman of the Executive Board on 1 January 2006 with a term of office of six years. Ingves term of office has been extended twice (6 years + 5 years) until 31 December 2022.

Governor Ingres joined Toronto Centre's board of directors in 1999, and became Chair in July 2018 after John Palmer retired as Chair.

Stefan Ingves holds a PhD in economics. Mr. Ingves has previously been Director of the Monetary and Financial Systems Department at the International Monetary Fund, Deputy Governor of the Riksbank and General Director of the Swedish Bank Support Authority. Prior to that he was Under-Secretary and Head of the Financial Markets Department at the Ministry of Finance.
